July 31 - August 9, 2011**

**July 31 – Depart Canada**

Tonight we board our overnight Trans-Atlantic flight to Paris.

**August 1 – Arrival Paris – Arras**

We are met by our Tour Director at Charles de Gaulle Airport in Paris, France. We immediately make our way to Beaumont Hamel to visit the site that commemorate Newfoundland's contribution to the First World War. Afterwards, we visit the Thiepval Monument and Interpretive Centre before our arrival at our hotel in Arras. This evening, we enjoy a welcome drink with our Tour Director and fellow travelers.

**August 2 – Arras – Dieppe**

This morning we visit the memorial at Vimy Ridge including a guided tour of the tunnels. Later, we visit the cemeteries of Neuville St. Vaast and La Targette for the German and French respectively. We also stop at the Canadian cemetery of Cabaret Rouge before heading for Normandy to visit the town of Puys. Finally, we arrive in Dieppe for the night. Dinner will be we served at a local restaurant before arrival at our hotel. **B D**

**August 3 – Dieppe – Bayeux**

This morning we tour Dieppe, visit the town of Pourville and stop at the Dieppe Canadian cemetery. After lunch, we make our way to the D-Day landing beaches area to visit the Pegasus Bridge Memorial and Museum. Then, we arrive at our hotel in Bayeux for the next five nights. **B L**

**August 4 – Bayeux – Canadian Sector: Juno Beach**

Today we visit the Juno Beach Centre where we enjoy a guided beach tour, an educational presentation entitled “History on Wheels”, and have some time to begin visiting the museum. After a catered lunch by the Centre, we make several stops in the towns of Courseulles-sur-Mer, Bernières-sur-Mer and St-Aubin-sur-Mer. We also stop at the Canadian Cemetery of Bény-sur-Mer in Revières. Later, we return to our hotel where dinner is served this evening. **B L D**

**August 5 – Bayeux – Canadian Sector: Battle of Normandy**

Today we return to the Juno Beach Centre where we have more time to visit both the permanent and temporary exhibits at the museum. After a brief ceremony and a catered lunch at the Mesnil Party, we visit the Abbaye d'Ardenne and meet Mr. Jacques Vico before returning to our hotel in Bayeux. **B L**

Today we visit Verrières Ridge and attend a ceremony at the Bretteville-sur-Laize Canadian Cemetery in Cintheaux. After lunch, we visit the Museum at Coudehard-Montormel. In the evening we enjoy dinner hosted by the Juno Beach Centre Association-Canada. We then return to our hotel in Bayeux. **B L D**

### **August 8 – Bayeux – Paris Sightseeing**

This morning we check out of our hotel in Bayeux and make our way back to Paris. Upon arrival, a local guide shows us the Arc de Triomphe, the Champs Elysées and we ascent up the Eiffel Tower for an unparalleled view of the city. The rest of the day is at leisure to explore the 'City of Light' further. **B**
